<p>Faculty/Staff Excellence in Volunteerism Award</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Must be nominated by Ivy Tech - Bloomington faculty, student or staff. 2. Self-nomination is permitted and encouraged. 3. Two (2) awards will be given unless unanimously agreed upon by Civic Engagement Committee. 4. Service can be completed anywhere in the world. 5. Faculty/staff must have been employed for at least one semester. 6. All part-time staff, full-time staff, adjunct faculty and full-time faculty are eligible. 7. Service between January 1, 2006 and January 1, 2007 will be considered. 8. Service must be primarily non-service learning related. 9. Award may be based on: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Description of volunteer service b. Impact of service c. Sustainability of service d. Substantiality of service (e.g. hours served) e. Reference by non profit benefiting from service (will be obtained by Civic Engagement Committee) 	<p>Student Excellence in Volunteerism Award</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Must be nominated by Ivy Tech - Bloomington faculty, student or staff. 2. Self-nomination is permitted and encouraged. 3. Two (2) awards will be given unless unanimously agreed upon by Civic Engagement Committee. 4. Service can be completed anywhere in the world. 5. All part-time and full-time credit-seeking students are eligible. 6. Service between January 1, 2006 and January 1, 2007 will be considered. 7. Service must have been performed during semester in which student was enrolled (all summer service is eligible regardless of enrollment status). 8. Student must have completed at least one semester of coursework. 9. Service must be primarily non-service learning related. 10. Award may be based on: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Description of volunteer service b. Impact of service c. Sustainability of service d. Substantiality of service (e.g. hours served) e. Reference by non profit benefiting from service (will be obtained by Civic Engagement Committee.)
<p>Excellence in Service Learning Award</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Project must be nominated by Ivy Tech - Bloomington faculty, student or staff. 2. Self-nomination is permitted and encouraged. 3. Two (2) awards will be given unless unanimously agreed upon by Civic Engagement Committee. 4. Service can be completed anywhere in the world. 5. Nominee projects must be curricula or project-based and awards can be given to multiple faculty, student and organization combinations. 6. Service learning projects that have happened, or are currently happening will be considered (e.g. spring '06, summer '06, fall '06 and spring '07). 7. Award may be based on: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Description of project's service b. Impact of service on community c. Impact on serving students d. Reference by non profit benefiting from service (will be obtained by Civic Engagement Committee.) 	<p>Jeanine C. Rae Humanitarian Award</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. One (1) award will be given. 2. All part-time, full-time, credit-seeking, continuing or graduating students are eligible. 3. Student must have completed at least two semesters of coursework. 4. Student must demonstrate outstanding humanitarian qualities (The dictionary defines a humanitarian as "a person whose attitudes and ways of life demonstrate concern for the well-being of others"). 5. Award may be based on student qualities including: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Relating well with peers. b. Doing an unusual amount to help someone else. c. Making contributions to the College that affect the well-being of others. d. Doing volunteer work – perhaps tutoring with no compensation. e. Being a morale booster or motivator – perhaps encouraging another student to complete his/her degree or certificate. f. Befriending someone in need of companionship.
<p>Community Organization Partner Award (Community Involvement Award)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Organization must be nominated by Ivy Tech – Bloomington faculty, student or staff. 2. Two (2) awards will be given unless unanimously agreed upon by Civic Engagement Committee. 3. Non profit must have been in existence for at least one year prior to nomination. 4. Organization must be within Ivy Tech – Bloomington's 6-county service area. 5. Award may be based on: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Description of service provided by non-profit b. Impact of non-profit's service on community c. Sustainability of non-profit in community d. Partnership with Ivy Tech – Bloomington
